Aims

Every child at Colegrave should be given the opportunity to appreciate the beauty of Art and Design. It is our duty as a school to ensure that children learn about the achievements of great artists and designers. They should be given the opportunity to learn how to draw, paint and sculpt as well as design and create objects in two and three dimensions.

Curriculum

Art and Design will be taught to our children using skills from the new curriculum. Teachers are given scope to plan units linked to the current topic whereby they can make links to different artists. Each year group will teach three units across the year, one per term, an hour a week. Each unit will explore various skills and the work of artist. At the end of each unit, children's work will be used for the communal displays.

Outcomes

Art units should be a sequence of lessons that promote drawing skills, techniques and show evidence of the final piece of art. Teachers must ensure that all units are taught. Please place each unit in the art folder and an evaluated copy in your planning folder.

Sketch books must be used throughout the year to record each unit. These books are the sole evidence of art being taught in our school.

Resources

All resources will have been pre order and given to year heads or allocated in the art cupboards in the west wing hall.

Visits

We encourage year groups to go on at least one Art visit during the year. Please find opportunities to link one of London's galleries to a unit.
