

Display Policy

Expectation	Rational
Link your display to a theme/related unit.	This will give your display a wow factor. You can add various things e.g. a background, 3D elements. Show off 😊
Ensure there is a colour scheme	You should only use two colours. (Lettering, backing of work)
Ensure that there is a clear and exciting.	This will attract the audience.
All work including lettering should be double mounted on card.	Mounting on card will ensure work remains intact for a longer period of time.
Cut the holes out from the letting.	This makes it look unattractive.
Use a guillotine to trim work/card.	This ensures that work is of high quality work and looks professional.
All work should be stapled in the corners.	This will ensure all elements of the display are straight.
Show the process of the work.	Include step by step process, photographs, practice samples etc.
Ask the audience question.	This will invite the audience.
Ensure words are typed/written correctly.	Make sure typed/written work is proof read.
Maximise the amount of space you are given for your display.	Spread work out, use the whole board. A bare board can look unattractive.
Display a range of work.	Ensure all children's work is displayed including SEN.
Maintain your display.	It is your responsibility to ensure that loose bits are amended/stapled back on.

All work to be of the highest standard.

Please ensure you allow pupils enough time to be able to produce work of a high standard. Remember these displays are viewed by pupils, parents, governors and visitors.
